## **DESCARTES**

Evil Demon – smart, powerful, deceitful, wants to trick me: everything outside of my mind is the effort of Evil Demon, so the question is how can I know anything

## COGITO, ERGO SUM!

If someone wants to trick me, then I must exist! If I exist, someone can trick me!

## FOUR RULES BY DESCARTES:

- 1. Do not accept anything as given if you have some reson to doubt it
- 2. Everything you want to examine divide into smaller pieces to find the best solutions
- 3. Order your thoughts from most simple ones toward more complex ones
- 4. Make general views on everything, so that you don't miss anything
